PENTECOST WEEK

◆ REFLECT & PREPARE ◆

DAY 1

REMEMBER THE PROMISE



SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 1:4-5



DAILY REFLECTION:

Before the fire fell in Acts 2, there was a waiting season in Acts 1. Jesus told the disciples not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father. Waiting does not mean abandonment – it means preparation.

Pentecost reminds us that God fulfills what He speaks. The disciples may not have fully understood what was coming, but they trusted the words of Jesus enough to stay positioned. There are promises over your life that may feel delayed, but Heaven has not forgotten them.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What promise from God have I stopped believing for?
- Have I remained spiritually positioned while waiting?
- What areas of my life need renewed expectation?



PRAYER FOCUS:

"Father, help me trust Your timing and remain positioned for Your promise. Renew my faith where disappointment tried to weaken me. Prepare my heart for what You desire to do in this season."



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

*I will not abandon what God promised me.
I am being prepared for fulfillment, power,
and purpose.*





PENTECOST WEEK

— REFLECT & PREPARE —

DAY 2

RETURN TO THE UPPER ROOM



SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 1:12-14

Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey away. And when they had come in, they went up into an upper room where they were staying...



DAILY REFLECTION:

The upper room became a place of unity, prayer, surrender, and expectation. Before there was power publicly, there was consecration privately.

God often prepares us in hidden places before revealing His power openly.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Have I made room for God in private?
- What distractions have pulled me away from intimacy?
- Am I pursuing God or just seeking results?



PRAYER FOCUS:

"Lord, draw me back into intimacy and prayer. Restore my hunger for Your presence."



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

I am returning to the place of prayer, unity, and surrender.





PENTECOST WEEK

REFLECT & PREPARE

DAY 3

CLEAN THE ALTAR



SCRIPTURE READING:

Psalm 51:10

*"Create in me a clean heart, O God,
and renew a right spirit within me."*



DAILY REFLECTION:

Fire fell on prepared altars throughout Scripture. Pentecost is not only about power — it is also about purity.

God desires surrendered hearts more than outward performance.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What areas of my life need cleansing?
- Have I allowed compromise to remain unchecked?
- Is my heart fully surrendered to God?



PRAYER FOCUS:

*"Create in me a clean heart, O God,
and renew a right spirit within me."*



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

*"My heart is becoming an altar
prepared for the fire of God."*





PENTECOST WEEK

REFLECT & PREPARE

DAY 4

STIR THE FIRE AGAIN



SCRIPTURE READING:

2 Timothy 1:6

"Fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands."



DAILY REFLECTION:

Some fires do not die suddenly — they fade slowly through neglect, disappointment, routine, or evaluation. Pentecost reminds us that God still ignites people today.

The Holy Spirit did not come to make us comfortable. He came to empower us.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- What passion has faded in my walk with God?
- Have I become spiritually passive?
- What gift or calling needs to be stirred again?



PRAYER FOCUS:

"Lord, stir the fire within me again. Awaken passion, boldness, and hunger."



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

"What God placed inside of me will not die. The fire is returning."





PENTECOST WEEK

— REFLECT & PREPARE —

DAY 5

WALK IN THE SPIRIT



SCRIPTURE READING:

Galatians 5:16

"So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."



DAILY REFLECTION:

Pentecost was never meant to be a one-day experience. The Holy Spirit was given so believers could live daily empowered lives.

God wants to lead us, guide us, correct us, and strengthen us through His Spirit.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Am I allowing the Holy Spirit to lead my decisions?
- What areas am I trying to control myself?
- How is the Holy Spirit speaking to His voice?



PRAYER FOCUS:

*"Holy Spirit, lead me daily.
Teach me obedience and sensitivity
to Your voice."*



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

*I will not walk according to the flesh.
I will walk in the Spirit.*





PENTECOST WEEK

— REFLECT & PREPARE —

DAY 6

KEEP THE UNITY



SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 2:1

"When the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place."



DAILY REFLECTION:

Unity creates the atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to move. Division, offense, and pride can grieve the Spirit and hinder His work.

The early church was unified in heart, purpose, and prayer.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Do I value unity more than my preferences?
- Is there anyone I need to forgive or reconcile with?
- How can I actively promote unity in my church, family, and community?



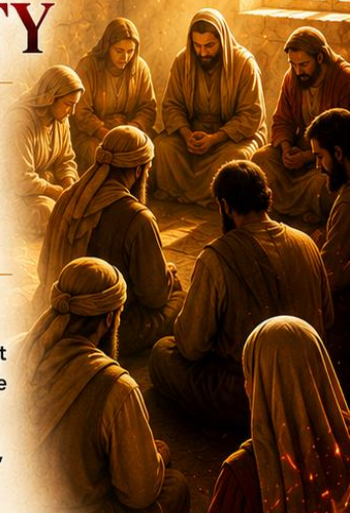
PRAYER FOCUS:

PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

I choose unity. I release peace. I align my heart with others for God's glory.

DAY 7

BE READY TO RECEIVE



SCRIPTURE READING:

Acts 1:8

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."



DAILY REFLECTION:

The promise has been given. The Holy Spirit is not only for the early church — He is for you today.

Be expectant. Be open. Be ready.

God wants to fill you afresh and send you out with His power and love.



REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

- Am I expectant for what God wants to do in me?
- What is holding me back from fully receiving?
- How can I be a witness for Jesus this week?



PRAYER FOCUS:

"Holy Spirit, I'm ready. Fill me afresh today. Empower me to live boldly and love like Jesus. Use me for Your glory."



PROPHETIC DECLARATION:

I receive the Holy Spirit. I walk in power, love, and boldness. I am sent to be a witness of Jesus Christ!
